PERMITTED USE OF THIS WEB SITE

The SD Cinematografica website contains images in medium resolution. Users are allowed to view and use the images only under the following conditions. SD Cinematografica reserves the right at any time to revoke the authorization to view, the right to use images and other information available at the site by giving written notice to the user, who on his part

will refrain from such use. SD Cinematografica reserves all rights not explicitly granted under this Agreement. Moreover, it strictly prohibits the use of software to perform searches within the SD Cinematografica site and/or to find information or images. SD Cinematografica reserves the right to terminate with immediate effect all licenses granted to users, without notice, if they fail to comply with the terms of this Agreement. The user can make use of low resolution images for up to thirty (30) days from the date of downloading the images for use in internal layouts and to assess their suitability. This does not allow the use of low-resolution images in the user's final product or other materials distributed externally, nor the modification in any way of the low resolution images. Finally, low resolution images may not be distributed, sublicensed or made available for use.

USE OF HIGH RESOLUTION IMAGES

The use of high resolution images is dictated solely by the terms and conditions established in a specific written contract between SD Cinematografica and the user.

Occasionally SD Cinematografica will inform the user of special promotions, new products and services, etc. SD Cinematografica will not disclose the information the user provides, including e-mail or postal addresses, to third party companies. SENSITIVE THEMES

Approval for the use of images for sensitive themes may take several days. Said approval will not be granted in all cases and persons depicted in certain circumstances may require additional payment for such use.
